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## **Цели и задачи:**

Основные цели и задачи письменного и устного собеседования по направлению 6В01701 «Иностранный язык: два иностранных языка»:

1. Оценка знаний и навыков: Важным аспектом собеседования является оценка общих знаний и навыков абитуриента в области английского языка. Комиссия проверяет владение грамматикой, словарным запасом, навыками чтения и письма на английском языке, а также знания в области лингвострановедения.

2. Оценка знаний и культурной осведомленности: Важной целью является оценка знаний и культурной осведомленности абитуриента в отношении стран, где используются целевые языки.

3. Оценка коммуникативных навыков: Одной из ключевых целей является оценка коммуникативных навыков абитуриента. Это включает способность эффективно общаться на английском языке, включая говорение и понимание на слух. Здесь комиссия интервьюирует абитуриентов, проверяет их способность выражать свои мысли и идеи, задавать вопросы и участвовать в диалоге на английском языке.

3. Оценка мотивации: Одной из целей собеседования является также оценка мотивации абитуриента для становления учителем английского языка. Это включает понимание источников их интереса к преподаванию английского языка, их понимания роли учителя и целей, которые они хотели бы достичь в этой профессии.

## **Структура и критерии оценивания письменного и устного собеседования**

Настоящая программа определяет содержание вступительного экзамена – письменного и устного собеседования с абитуриентами на базе высшего и среднего специального образования, поступающих в СКУ им. М. Козыбаева по направлению 6В01701 «Иностранный язык: два иностранных языка». Программа вступительного экзамена разработана в соответствии с ГОСО среднего специального образования.

Программа разработана на кафедре «Германо-романская филология» и предназначена для подготовки и проведения вступительного экзамена (письменного и устного собеседования) для обучения по ОП 6В01701 «Иностранный язык: два иностранных языка». В программе содержатся общие сведения об организации и проведении экзамена, перечень тем и вопросов, знание которых определяет теоретический уровень подготовленности поступающих, список литературы по каждой дисциплине, критерии оценивания.

Во время собеседования абитуриент должен показать знания и уметь кратко и понятно отвечать на заданные вопросы.

### **1. Структура.**

Собеседование состоит из двух частей:

1. Первая часть собеседования письменная – проводится в виде письменного теста на проверку знаний грамматики и лексики английского языка (Use of English), а также на проверку уровня владения навыком чтения (reading skills) и знания в сфере лингвострановедения.
2. Вторая часть собеседования устная – проводится в виде интервью на английском языке, цель которого проверить уровень владения навыками аудирования и говорения (listening and speaking skills).

Время, отводимое абитуриенту на прохождение письменной части составляет 50-60 минут.

Время, отводимое абитуриенту на прохождение устной части, интервью составляет 10-15 минут. В течение этого времени абитуриент отвечает на вопросы членов комиссии.

## 2. Критерии оценивания

По результатам вступительного экзамена выставляются оценки по балльно-рейтинговой буквенной системе оценки знаний обучающихся. При этом принимается во внимание уровень теоретической и практической подготовки претендента.

Комиссия определяет:

- соответствие уровня теоретической и практической подготовки абитуриента установленным общеобязательным стандартам профессионального образования;
- фактический уровень знаний, умений и практических навыков абитуриента по практическому обучению, общепрофессиональным и специальным дисциплинам, их соответствие требованиям учебных программ и квалифицированных характеристик по специальности.

Результаты сдачи вступительного экзамена объявляются в день их проведения после подписания протоколов заседания приемной комиссии.
